This funding will be used to


- Ensure the implementation of a schoolwide Reading program at Sharon State School in 2019.
- Ensure 100% of students in Year 3 and 5 are achieving National Minimum Standards in Reading.
- Increase the percentage of students in Years 3 and 5 achieving results in the Upper Two Bands in Reading, Targets- Year 3- Above 75% and Year 5 above 50%.

Our initiatives include


- Employing additional Teacher Aide time to assist with intervention and reading programs as part of the schools reading program.
- Employing additional Teacher Aides to work with students identified as needing support or extension in small groups or as individuals.
- Employing a teacher to collect and input Early Start data into OneSchool.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Employing additional Teacher Aide time to support and work with students individually and in small groups - \$ 43 014
- Employing a teacher 0.2 Full Time Equivalent to collect and input early start data into Oneschool- \$21 000
