This funding will be used to

- Build greater alignment of student assessment against the Australian Curriculum Standards through enabling teachers to be involved in regular CASW (Collaborative Assessment of Student Work) and Moderation.
- Ensure full staff involvement in PBL (Positive Behaviour for Learning), Wellbeing and Support team meetings
- Improve differentiation in classrooms, particularly during writing lessons
- Improve ICT (Information Communication Technology) skills for all students

Our initiatives include

- Provide relief for teachers to be part of weekly Principal led CASW and Moderation checkin's, PBL team meetings, Well being team meetings and Support team meetings.
- Digital Technology KLA (key learning area); and ICT skills linked to English assessments each term by a specialist teacher. Classroom Teachers to build their capacity through mentoring and co-teaching with this "knowledgeable other."
- Purchasing of 9 computers for 2-4 classrooms to support English extension and access for Assessment tasks for students.
- Purchase of an additional teacher-aid hours for Prep to Year 4, to support students in writing during English blocks.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

Purchase Teacher hours .1 FTE (Fractional Teaching Equivalent); to release teachers to participate in school priority activities	\$10,000
Purchase teacher aide hours: 30 Teacher aide hours (2 x aides) per week	\$30,000
Training and devices for technology to further strengthen ICT skills in P-6 students	\$7,908
